

Pupil Premium Funding at The Coombes Primary School

The Pupil Premium Grant (PPG) is additional funding given to schools to support children with their learning and development. Schools choose how to spend this money to make sure pupils who receive it have the best possible outcomes to raise the attainment of disadvantaged pupils of all learning levels and to close the gaps between them and their peers.

If your child is eligible, they will receive this funding for the next 6 years.

Therefore, this extra funding could make a huge difference to their educational outcomes.

The way schools spend the funding is detailed in the Pupil Premium Strategy.

At The Coombes, we prioritise access to learning, ensuring pupils have high-quality resources to learn with both at home and at school, as well as a variety of additional experiences to enhance school life.

These include:

- Interventions or In-School Tutoring
- Reading books and additional reading session in school
- Nurture support
- Support with home learning

As well as

- New or replacement school uniform and or PE Kit
- Contributions towards the cost of School Trips including residentials
- Funded access to an externally provided after school clubs (1 term per year per child)
- Free school meals, including on school trips

Who is eligible for Pupil Premium Funding?

- Pupils who have a parent in the Armed Forces
- Pupils who are eligible for Free School Meals (FSM)
- Pupils who have been eligible for Free School Meals (FSM) in the past 6 years

If you as a parent/carer claim or have claimed any of the following

- Income Support
- Income-based Job Seekers Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Universal Credit
- Working Tax Credit
- Child Tax Credit
- Support under part 6 of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
