



Dear Parents and Carers,

Your child's school is taking part in a new local project aimed at improving inclusivity for all SEN children within mainstream schools – Partnership for Inclusion of Neurodiversity in Schools (PINS). This project is being run by Send Voices Wokingham who work with parents of children with additional needs in the Wokingham borough to ensure their voices are heard within the Local authority and Health.

The project includes 30 schools across the borough and each will have up to 3 Parent forum meetings. Parents/Carers will be invited into an informal meeting, within school where one of the PINS officers will listen to your ideas, what the school is doing well and areas for improvement. We then feed this back, anonymously to the school to help improve inclusivity of our children. Acting as a central voice for all parents/carers and helping to come up with positive ways to help our children thrive.
