


Word	Definition
Rhyme	Words that sound the same in their endings
Syllable	Part of a word that contains sounds can also be called a beat.
Alliteration	Using more than one word that starts with the same letters
Pirate	A person who sailed the sea to search for ships to attack for treasure
Jolly Roger	A traditional flag used to identify pirate ships
Habitat	The home of an animal or plant
Coral Reef	An underwater ecosystem
Ecosystem	A community of living and non-living things

Pirates <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Blackbeard was the most feared pirate.• Not every pirate ship used the Jolly Roger, pirates had their flags specially made.• It is thought pirates wore eye patches to help them see in the dark for going below deck.• Every pirate ship had their own set of rules like who would do the chores and how the treasure would be shared.	
Under the Sea <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Around 70% of the Earth is covered by Oceans.• The largest Ocean on Earth is the Pacific Ocean.• Less than 5% of the Earth's Oceans have been explored.• Octopuses have 3 hearts and blue blood.• Jellyfish have been around longer than dinosaurs.
