

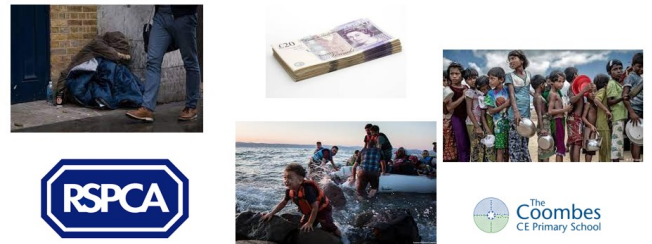
Knowledge Organiser for Year 3/4 (PSHCE)

Key idea: Me and My Money

Tier 3 Vocabulary	
Needs	Needs are things we must have to survive, such as food, water, and shelter.
Want	Wants are desires for goods and services we would like to have but do not need
Value of money	Its worth, usefulness, or importance
Skill	The ability, coming from one's knowledge, practice, aptitude, etc., to do something well
Attribute	A quality or feature of a person
Full-time	Often requires a commitment of 37-40 hours per week.
Part-time	Is any schedule less than full-time employment
Shift work	Hours can cycle between day shifts (7:00 AM to 3:00 PM), night shifts (1:00 PM to 9:00 PM), and weekend, night, or overnight shifts.
Paid	You are paid for your work.
Voluntary	Work for free.
Job Sector	Job sectors are areas of the economy which include various occupations.

Knowledge item 1:

Everyone has a different value of money– based on their circumstances, needs and wants.



Knowledge item 2:

People get jobs to generate money to pay for their wants and needs.

They can work:

- Full-time (37-40 hours per week)
- Part-time (less than full time)
- Shift work. (days/nights/weekends)
