Tom has 7 five pound notes. How much money does he have?

A restaurant sold 6 sandwiches every day for a week. How many sandwiches were sold during the week?

Luke, Keith and Sandy each have 7 rubbers. How many rubbers do they have altogether?

Nancy was at the beach for 5 days and found 6 seashells every day. How many seashells did Nancy find during her beach trip?

John has 6 balloons. Nancy has 4 times more balloons than John. How many balloons does Nancy have?

There are 12 biscuits in a packet. Eve has 3 packets for her party. How many biscuits does she have altogether?

There are 9 sheep in a field. Each sheep has 3 lambs. How many lambs are in the field?

8 aliens land on earth. Each alien has 3 eyes. How many eyes are there in total?
