#### Vocabulary

Word	Definition
Planet	An object in space that orbits round a star.
Solar System	A collection of planets and their moons in orbit around the sun, together with asteroids and comets.
Orbit	The curved path an object takes to travel around a star or planet.
Astronaut	A person who is trained to travel in a spacecraft
Perseverance	Keeping going in completing something despite difficulty or delay in achieving success.
Growth mind-set	Believing in yourself and the power of your brain. Knowing that with practise we will get better at something.
Disguise	Using a different appearance to hide your true identity.
Bravery	Courageous behaviour or character when faced with a challenge.

##### Space

- There are 8 planets in our solar system alongside Pluto, a dwarf planet.
- The sun is a big star. Stars are burning balls of fire.
- Some planets have moons e.g. Titan is Saturn's biggest moon.
- The planets orbit the sun and gain heat from the sun's energy.

##### Superheroes

- Superheroes wear costume to help them to be disguised.
- Superheroes are often brave and show resilience.
- Superheroes persevere in difficult times and have a growth mind-set.
- Everyone can be a superhero even if they can't fly.
