## Making links

Construct a memory map of what you have just learnt (this may be focused around the whole topic or just today's lesson)

## 3B4

Write down 3 things you know now but didn't before.

## Infographic

Design a poster that captures the key points of today's learning.

## 5 Questions

Write down 5 questions anyone should be able to answer about this topic if they have learnt it properly.

## The Gallery

Draw a picture that recaps the main lesson points or sums up the lesson.

It can be literal, abstract, stick figures, cartoonish or a mind map/spider diagram.

## Ranked Learning

List everything you have learnt this lesson.

Once done, order your list from most to least important.

Be ready to justify your choices.

## Digging Deeper

Write down the questions you still have about the topic, and which you do not feel have been answered yet.

## Keywords

What are the essential key words for this topic?  
List them in your book.

Then write a clue or definition for each keyword.

## Reading and re-writing

Read through your work and the textbook pages related to this lesson.

Write down the 3 most important things you have just read about. Now select the most important and write it in your own words.

## Teach a child

Write down how you would teach someone younger than you what you have just learnt.

## 1,3,5,7

What is the **1** most significant thing you have just learnt?  
What are the **3** essential pieces of information a learner would have to know about the subject you have just learnt?  
Write down **5** questions you would want answered about this subject.  
Write down a **7** bullet point summary of this topic.

## KAPE

What are the **key** points in summary?  
How will you now **apply** this information?  
How will you make **personal** use of this information?  
What **evidence** is there for the truth of this information?
